About Scott

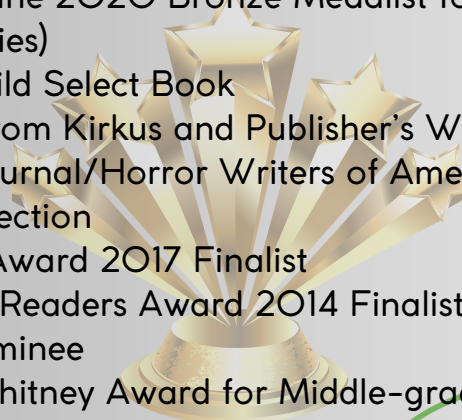
J. Scott Savage is the author of 23 published novels. He has been a teacher, presenter, and keynote speaker at writing conferences for adults and youth, and has developed Common Core-aligned projects for elementary school writing curricula. Scott currently serves on the advisory board of Operation Literacy, which runs Teen Author Boot Camp, one of the largest teen writing conferences in the country. He has presented at more than 4000 schools, libraries, and conferences across the country, inspiring students to read, write, embrace their own creativity, and change the world. He is represented by Michael Bourret of Dystel, Goderich, & Bourret.

Scott's new release, ***Quantum Interstellar Sports League***, is a highly illustrated middle-grade novel from Penguin Workshop, made its debut September 24, 2024. Scott is also the author of several other popular series, including ***Graysen Foxx***, ***The Wonderland Diaries***, ***Mysteries of Cove***, and ***FarWorld***, published by Shadow Mountain. Scott is also the author of the ***Case File 13*** middle-grade series published by HarperCollins. Scott's work has also appeared in anthologies like ***True Heroes*** and ***Altered Perceptions***.

Scott lives in Utah with his wife of 37 years, Jennifer. He has four amazing children, and nine perfect grandchildren. He enjoys reading, watching movies, camping, traveling, and spending time with his family.

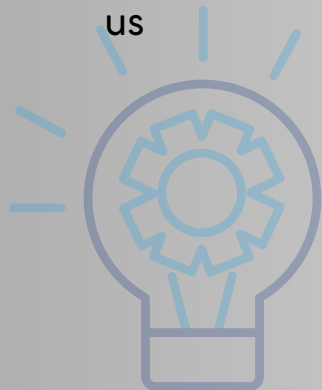
